



# 2019 Waterside Series

## Important Notes when paying by Online Banking:

### Use of "Online Banking" to pay for your Waterside 2019 entry

- 1) Entry Form must have arrived by GPO post on or before the Wednesday prior to your first Race, or 6<sup>th</sup> February 2019 if entering the Series or Race A is your first.
- 2) Online payment must also be showing in our bank account on the Wednesday, before the event. Advice: Allow 3-4 Banking days for the Transfer as not all payments are set to transfer via the Fast Payment method. [ See also 1) above for series and Race A differences ]
- 3) **The entry form is the key document. If this is not received by the Wednesday prior to the event.** If this is not the case, you will need to pay the additional LATE ENTRY FEE. [ See also 1) above for series and Race A differences ]
- 4) There is NO race entry advantage or disadvantage by electing to pay online as opposed to paying with a cheque.

**This Reference needs to be as above regardless of who makes the payment.**

The Reference has a limited number of characters so please adhere to this guideline otherwise we may not be able to match your payment to your entry. For K2 entries please use the Surname of the First named paddler on the entry form. *Please limit the length of long surnames by truncating so as to be able to add the Class number's one or two digits.*

- 6) On the Entry form please tick the Box stating that Payment has been made online
- 7) Remember: Even if you intend to pay by Internet Banking – **POST YOUR ENTRY FORM!**

*This statement is in line with Rule 26 allowing us to implement this additional payment method.*

Additional Note: Please refer to the Information Sheet for further information regarding the priority preference awarded to Series/Race A entries as *entries may be limited depending on demand.*
